Enjoy a full day of sightseeing in the capital city, Thimpu, including a visit to the National Memorial Chorten, the National Textile Museum, the Folk Heritage Museum, and the School of Traditional Painting of Arts and Craft. The pass to Punakha offers the most spectacular view over the high peaks of the eastern Himalayas. Pass through dense forests of Oak and Rhododendron trees, reaching Gangtey (Phubjika) and to Paro. You'll be mesmerized to see the silvery Pa Chu (Paro River) flowing down the valley, the Paro Dzong (fortress), and Ta Dzong (watch tower). With a visit to the famous Taktsang Gompa (Tiger's Nest Monastery), the Bhutan culture tour ends. This program offers a rare opportunity to savor the different cultures and customs of unique valleys.

- Day 7 - Trip to Paro(2250 Mtr) 130 KM,4 hour
