

Dhaulagiri Circuit Trek



Trip Overview

The trek named Dhaulagiri comes after the world's seventh-highest mountain Mt Dhaulagiri (8167 Mtr), which is located in the western part of Nepal. It is an extremely challenging adventure destination in Nepal Himalaya, however diverse culture, high alpine pastures, uninhabited valleys, high windswept passes, forests, and cultivated terraced hills, treading through different types of forest to treeless zones and getting as close as possible to peak like Dhaulagiri and dhampus peaks are great highlights of Dhaulagiri circuit trek. Dhaulagiri rises above the deepest gorge in the world, the Kali Gandaki, and the circuit route provides stunning views of the whole Dhaulagiri range and Tukucho Peak. The route of the circuit was discovered in the 1950s by a French team, hence the French pass, which leads into a lonely area known as Hidden Valley.

- Day 14 - Acclimatization Day.
- Day 15 - Cross French Pass (5,360 Mtr/17580 Ft) and Trek to Hidden Valley (5,200 Mtr/17056 Ft))
- Day 16 - Cross Dhampus Pass (5,200 Mtr/17056 Ft) and Trek to Yak Kharka (3,680 Mtr/12070 Ft))
- Day 17 - Trek to Marpha(2665 Mtr/8741 Ft)
- Day 18 - Trek to Lete(2470 Mtr/8107 Ft)
- Day 20 - Trek to Gorepani (2775 Mtr/9102 Ft)
- Day 21 - Trek to Birethanti and drive to Pokhara
- Day 22 - Sightseeing in Pokhara
- Day 24 - Final Departure
