

Jomolhari Trek



Trip Overview

Jomolhari (7,513m) Trek is one of Bhutan's most popular and attractive high-altitude treks. The trek begins and ends in Paro where we also visit the famous Taktsang(Tiger's Nest) Monastery. Jomolhari Trek is longer than the Jomolhari Loop the most popular trekking route in Bhutan. With altitude differences of 2,500m and nearly 5,000m, it offers a wide range of landscapes, fauna, and flora. The highlight of this trek is the spectacular view of Mount Jomolhari from Jomolhari Basecamp (Jangothang). Jomolhari Trek with Cultural Tour is a package designed for adventure lovers who would love to add spice to the trekking experience of their Bhutan cultural tour. Bhutan is a land of heavenly beauty. This Trek with cultural tour includes a hike to Tiger's Monastery and a sightseeing tour to Memorial Chorten, Wangditse Monastery, Nunnery temple, School of Art and Crafts, Changangkha Monastery, and many more. It is an opportunity to learn about the unique Buddhist culture prevalent in Bhutan. The snow-capped mountains, lush hills, forests, rivers, valleys, and long-treasured architecture are the assets that make Bhutan so special. Walking by the streets of Bhutan, you will find the influence of unique and unadulterated Buddhist culture. The temples, monasteries, and dzongs are truly artistic and resemble the Tibetan Buddhist culture. Talking about its uniqueness in religion, it is the only country able to sustain itself as a Mahayana Buddhist state. Also, popular as the Land of Thunder Dragon, Bhutan is a sacred land located in the Eastern Himalayas between two giant nations India and China.

- Day 6 - Rest day at Jangothang, Jumolhari Base Camp(4115 Mtr)
- Day 7 - Trek to Lingshi(4100 Mtr)
- Day 8 - Trek to Shodu(4100 Mtr)
- Day 9 - Trek to Barshong(3600 Mtr)
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- Day 10 - Trek to Dolam Kencho(3320 Mtr)
- Day 11 - Trek to -Dodena-Thimphu Trek ends
- Day12 - Final departure
