Trip Itinerary

- Day 1: - Arrive in Kathmandu valley via a flight at Tribhuvan International Airport.(1400 Mtr/4592 Ft)
- Day 2 - Full day observe and explore Kathmandu Valley.
- Day 3 - Sightseeing Kathmandu Valley
- Day 4 - Drive from Kathmandu to Pokhara (6 hours)
- Day 5 - Whole day sightseeing in Pokhara
- Day 6 - Drive back to Kathmandu from Pokhara
- Day 7 - Arrive in Paro and drive to Thimpu. (2 hours)
- Day 8 - Exploration of Thimpu and travel to Punakha(1250 Mtr/4100 Ft). 3-4 hours
- Day 9 - Observe Punakha Dzong and take a ride to Paro. (4 hrs)
- Day 10 - Trekking trail to Taktsang Lhakhang (Tiger's Nest)
- Day 11 - Departure from Paro to your native destination
